- 1. Chair Silver called the meeting to order at 5:30 p.m.
- 2. Members present were Chair Silver, Alderpersons Thomas and Edmonds. Also present were City Administrator Krider, Street Department Manager Hess, Alderperson Dohm, residents Marlene Carter, Colin Corbett, Matt Dillon, Bonnie Farrell, Priscilla Peterson, and Clerk Barnes.
- 3. There were no Additions to/or Deletions from the Agenda.
- 4. A Motion to approve the Minutes from the March 15, 2023 regular meeting was made by Alderperson Thomas and seconded by Alderperson Edmonds. Motion carried.
- 5. A Motion to receive and file the Monthly Financial Reports from February 2023 was made by Alderperson Thomas and seconded by Alderperson Edmonds. Motion carried.
- 6. Administrator's Report She has been working on the Budget and other agenda items.
- 7. Street Department Manager's Report Idaho Sidewalk Project is ready to go except for waiting on Comcast to move the wiring to other poles. Comcast is waiting for their people to have other jobs in the area to do. The contractor has another couple of weeks before they must begin the project. The Arthur Street apron for the alley that was eroding has been changed from asphalt to concrete. Now it only needs to be grass seeded to complete that project. Street sweeping was completed last Monday. Clean-Up Day is ready except for the delivery of the dumpsters.
- 8. Public Comment Thank you to Street Department Manager Hess for getting the information of street sweeping to the Community page. It is appreciated.
- 9. Unfinished Business
  - a. Idaho Sidewalk Program update given during the report by Street Department Manager's Report.
  - b. Ardmore Place Sidewalk update a walk-through of the area is set up for a field survey next week. The area has not improved over the winter.
  - c. Traffic at Waverly Avenue and Callender Avenue update Discussions continue to search for solutions.
  - d. Vaughn/Magnolia update letters were presented that will go out soon to each of the property owners of the area via certified mail. Page 4 of the papers sent would be a copy of the individual property and the impact the project would have on it. Since there was little response last time for a meeting to explain the project, it was requested that "Open Immediately!" or "Important - Response Needed" or something like that be put on the envelope.
