FY 2025 goals

- 1) Review City Code sections pertaining to Public Safety and pursue revisions as needed to promote a better quality of life for residents in West Peoria.
- 2) Monitor potential improvements in animal control.
- 3) Address nuisance properties.
- 4) Work with various entities to improve street lighting within the city.
- 5) Enact a “Slow Down West Peoria” campaign to slow down drivers.
- 6) Research all the aspects of what the Public Safety Committee is in charge of and work with fellow members of the committee and Council on potential improvements and innovations.
- 7) Continue working on the speed limit and signage issues.
- 8) Develop and survey residents about some of the issues – public involvement.
