

- 1. Mayor Dillon called the meeting to Order at 7:00 p.m. and led the Pledge of Allegiance.
- Roll Call: Members present were Mayor Dillon, Alderpersons Dohm, Dillon, Abraham, Ruskusky, Menke, and Silver. Alderpersons Corbett and Mathewson were absent. Also present were City Administrator Krider, City Treasurer McGill, residents Marlene Carter, Bob DeSutter, Sharon Kennedy, Emily Waite, and Clerk Barnes. City Attorney Connor and residents Susan Schlupp and John Siewert II attended remotely.
- 3. There were no Additions to/or Deletions from the Agenda.
- 4. A Motion to Approve Minutes from the regular meeting of July 11, 2023 was made by Alderperson Abraham and seconded by Alderperson Dohm. Discussion: There was no discussion. On Wednesday, August 2, 2023 everyone has been invited to greet the students on their first day back to school for the new year. This begins at 7:00 a.m. Come and join in encouraging the students to have a great new year.

Tri-County Regional Planning Commission will be overseeing a core study in the area of Callender and Waverly to figure out a solution to the traffic congestion there. Rebuild IL project is coming along. Our monthly radar review showed that once again there were speeders, but over-all the daily average is still at or under the posted speed limit. The Vaughn/Magnolia project is still being discussed as to how the problem can be solved. The Committee entered into an Executive Session to review previous Executive Session Minutes.
