Dear Parade Participant,

Thank you for your interest in participating in the 51st annual 4th of July Parade sponsored by the City of West Peoria. We are proud to be the longest-running 4th of July parade in Central Illinois and would be honored if you and/or your organization would march along with us. Attached with this letter are the following documents for you to review and complete if you wish to enter the 4th of July Parade.

All documents and proof of Insurance for those driving licensed vehicles must be returned by <u>Friday, June 16th</u>. Please provide your email address to ensure the City will be able to forward you an email with your Parade Position Number. Your email address will not be provided to any other entity. *It will be the duty of the recipient of the Parade Position Number to inform all participants of your registered Name and Parade Position Number.*

<u>Parade Information</u>: The Parade will start at 10:00 am on Tuesday, July 4, 2023, at the corner of Rohmann Ave and Sterling Ave. All participants must be ready and in position no later than 9:45 am. *There will be no through traffic on Rohmann Ave beginning at 8:00 am the day of the parade.* The parade will go on rain or shine. Please be prepared for the weather. Additionally, please be aware that due to the number of participants, the duration of the parade can last anywhere from one hour to one and a half.

<u>Parade Assembly Area</u>: Access to the line-up area will only be from Farmington Rd to Swords Ave. Information as to your staging area will be available at the check-in center on the corner of Swords/Alice Ave. Groups are to assemble in their staging area according to their Position Number, or they may gather at Harold B. Dawson (Calvin Coolidge) Middle School.

Parade Vehicle Line-Up: Begins at Rohmann/Sterling Ave. down Rohmann Ave. to Swords Ave.


<u>Parade Route</u>: Sterling to Moss Ave, across to Waverly Ave, up to Rohmann Ave, continuing onto Sterling Ave again, and concludes at the Franciscan Recreation Complex at the intersection of Sterling Ave and Heading Ave. See the attached map.

<u>Flag Raising Ceremony:</u> At the end of the parade, everyone is invited to gather at the Community flagpole located in Franciscan Park. This is where the awards will be presented for the winning entries.

Your early response is appreciated, so please try to return the enclosed forms by no later than **June 16**th.

THE 51st ANNUAL 4th OF JULY PARADE PARADE RULES AND REGULATIONS

The Parade will start at 10:00 am on Tuesday, July 4, 2023 at the corner of W. Rohmann Ave. and Sterling Ave. All participants must check-in, be ready and in position no later than 9:45 am. A parade check-in center will be set up near the corner of Swords and Alice Ave. There will be no through traffic on Rohmann Ave. beginning at 8:00 am the day of the parade. The parade will go on rain or shine. Please be prepared for the weather. Additionally, please be aware that due to the number of participants, the duration of the parade can be anywhere from one hour to one and a half. Please ensure that participants in your group are aware of this and bring plenty of water to stay hydrated.

The Deadline for Parade Entries is Friday, June 16th, at 5:00 pm.

Drivers of all vehicles in the parade must possess a valid driver's license, provide the City with proof of vehicle liability insurance (minimum of \$300,000 coverage), and be at least 18 years old.

All Parade Entries must be pre-registered with the City to participate and must check in at the corner of Swords and Alice Ave. on the day of the Parade.

All Entries must have an identifying banner.

- Antique Cars, Custom Vehicles, or Motorcycles may be entered individually or as part of a group.
- Business units may enter the parade if decorated to promote the business <u>and</u> the 4th of July celebration.
- Politicians may enter the parade as a separate unit or ride on a float designated for their party.

All banners and decorations must be respectful, family-friendly, and keeping with the theme of celebrating our Independence and honoring those who have sacrificed to ensure our freedom. A brief description of the parade entry is required on the application. The Parade announcer will use the description as each entry passes the Judges' stand.

Float entries must be on a hayrack or flatbed trailer. No participants are to get on or exit the float once the parade begins its forward motion.

Position Numbers are given out on the day of the Parade and are to be displayed by the first person of an entry or in the front right-hand corner for all vehicles to identify each entry.

Candy may be distributed from the parade units:

- Candy may be thrown **underhanded** directly to spectators or the <u>sidewalk</u> where children are present;
- Walkers are to be a minimum of 3 feet away from a moving unit when distributing candy or handouts;
- Entries cannot stop along the parade route to refill candy containers; and
- PLEASE DO NOT TOSS ANYTHING IN THE STREET, AS WE DO NOT WANT CHILDREN IN THE STREET

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Shredded Paper or Toilet Paper Rolls are not to be projected from any of the walkers, floats, or vehicles.

Entries must keep their unit moving along the parade route with no more than 6 feet between their unit and the unit in front of them. Please follow Parade Volunteers' directions to ensure continuous movement and avoid excessive space between entries in the Parade.

Alcoholic beverages, Cannabis, or other drugs are forbidden on any entry, in any vehicle, or on any person in the parade assembly area and throughout the parade route. Participants consuming alcohol, cannabis, or any other drugs in the assembly area will be removed from the parade. All City, County and State statutes concerning the consumption of such will be strictly enforced by the Peoria County Sheriff's Department prior to the start of the parade, during the parade, and after the parade.

Awards will be given for the following categories at the Flag Raising Ceremony following the Parade: Most Patriotic, Best of Show, Best Service Organization, and Best Juvenile Entry.

The City of West Peoria reserves the right to restrict, limit, reject or remove any entry/unit before and during the parade if it does not abide by the stated Parade Rules and Regulations.

All decisions are final.

The undersigned contact person for the named entry and/or any of its participants agrees to waive, release and discharge the City of West Peoria, any of its officials or staff; the County of Peoria, and the State of Illinois from any and all liabilities for damages, death, personal injury, or property damage which the named entry and/or any of its participants in whole, or in part, during the assembly of the parade line-up, the movement of the parade along the parade route and the leaving of the parade route.
