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- 1. Mayor Dillon called the meeting to Order at 7:00 p.m. and led the Pledge of Allegiance.
- Roll Call: Members present were Mayor Dillon, Alderpersons Dohm, Dillon, Mathewson, Ruskusky, Menke, and Silver. Alderpersons Abraham and Corbett were absent, as was City Treasurer McGill. Also present were City Administrator Krider, residents Bonnie Farrell and Emily Waite, Deputy Gavin Watland, and Clerk Barnes. City Attorney Connor and residents Priscilla Peterson and Susan Schlupp attended remotely.
- 2. There were no Additions to/or Deletions from the Agenda.

- 4. Community Police Report was given by Deputy Gavin Watland. There have been multiple vehicular break-ins and 2 vehicular thefts. Those 2 stolen vehicles have been recovered. There was a shooting at Mike's Tavern on Cedar with one person shot. The shooter was arrested within 20 minutes. Mayor Dillon praised the police for their good work on this.
- 5. Mayor's Report included that there was another incident this morning on Manor Parkway. A young adult posted comments on Facebook about a rival gang and they retaliated by shooting up a house. This is a good reason for staying off Facebook with any such comments. The City is switching banks to the Bank of Farmington. Their Board is meeting this evening to decide on whether or not to have a branch here in the City. If they decide to try it there will have to be State and Federal involvement. There may also be an ITM similar to an ATM near City Hall. An ITM is more sophisticated than an ATM with video ability.
